## Safety Recommendations

1. Wear bright orange or yellow safety vests.
2. Wear heavy duty work gloves.
3. Wear sturdy shoes, hats, long sleeves and long pants to avoid falls, sun exposure, scratches, bugs, and exposure to poisonous plants.
4. Stay away from edge of roadways and face oncoming traffic.
5. Get permission before going on private property.
6. Do not remove any unknown, suspicious or known hazardous substances.
7. Do not open coolers, jugs, bottles or other sealed items.
8. Report any suspicious items to police.
9. Do not attempt to remove heavy items.
10. Be alert for snakes, rodents and ticks.
11. Supervise children.
