This is an update on the status of roadway and drainage construction on Concord Street.

New storm sewer has been constructed from Madison Street to the intersection of Concord Street and West 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Storm sewer construction will continue to occur along Concord Street from West 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue to West 9<sup>th</sup> Street from **Friday, November 20 through Wednesday, November 25**. During this time, Concord Street from West 9<sup>th</sup> Street to West 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed to all traffic, and parking will not be available. Residents are asked to park along Charles Street and Madison Street.

**Starting Monday, November 30, Concord Street is planned to be closed between West 9<sup>th</sup> Street and West 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and the closure will remain for several weeks through the remainder of construction** as road reconstruction work is occurring. Parking and driveway access will therefore not be available along these blocks of Concord Street. **Vehicles will need to be parked along Charles Street and Madison Street by Sunday night.** We request residents on the south side of Madison Street park in their driveways (off of Lemon Street) as much as possible while Concord Street is closed to free up parking on Madison Street for the north side properties. We again recognize that parking is limited, so we sincerely appreciate your cooperation. West 10<sup>th</sup> Street will remain open to through traffic from Madison Street to Charles Street throughout this construction.

Trash and recycling collections between West 9<sup>th</sup> Street and West 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue will continue to occur along Charles Street and Madison Street until further notice.

**Please note that trash and recycling cans must be placed within easy reach of the collection crew along the edge of the street. Cans may be placed on the sidewalk and curb on collection days to accommodate ease of access from the street. Any cans that are placed behind fences or not placed within easy reach from the street will not be collected. Cans must be removed from the sidewalk and other public walkways during non-collection days.**
